



2017 Horizontal Curve Alignment Signing

Purpose/Topics Covered: Roadway departure crashes account for approximately 67% of crash related fatalities. Across the state, 20% of all crashes take place on a curve and 40% of the fatal crashes occur while driving on a curve. The Horizontal Alignment Signing training course focuses on the aspects of assessing curve advisory speeds and the use of proper curve signing. This course will train individuals to record data taken from the assessment of curves, use horizontal alignment technology, and install proper signage, including curve advisory speed. Participants will be given a basic introduction on how to find and use crash data to determine which curves are at a higher risk for crashes. Participants will also be introduced to the CARS method for determining appropriate curve advisory speeds.

Fee: The Horizontal Curve Alignment Signing course is open only to local government agencies in Kentucky. Thanks to the Accelerated Safety Activities Program grant, local governments may attend this one-day training session at no cost.

Confirmation/Cancellation: Participants will receive a confirmation letter and map with directions prior to the workshop. If registered and unable to attend, please inform us at least three business days prior to the workshop. Someone may substitute for you at any time.

Class Participation: Participants will be expected to drive a course to assess curve speed using a ball bank indicator. Participants are asked to please bring proper PPE with you to this training. The ball bank indicators will be temporarily mounted on the dashboard of each vehicle used. You will be grouped in teams of two.
