Purpose/Topics Covered: The Traffic and Safety Academy is designed to offer local governments training to reduce roadway departures and fatalities. Speakers include subject experts from the Federal Highway Administration, the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, and local governments within Kentucky. The Academy includes topics in four training tracks: Technology (including topics such as Examining Crash Data and Asset Management), Regulations and Guidelines (including topics like Risk Management and Communicating with your District Office), Design (including Intersection Safety and Alternative Designs), and Assessment (including Low-Cost Safety for Rural Roads, Sign Retroreflectivity, and Traffic Management).

Fee: The Traffic and Safety Academy is open only to local government agencies in Kentucky. Thanks to the Accelerated Safety Activities Program grant, local governments may attend this two-day session at no cost. Due to space limitations, each agency is limited to sending up to three individuals.

Confirmation/Cancellation: Participants will receive a confirmation letter and map with directions prior to the workshop. If registered and unable to attend, please inform us at least three business days prior to the workshop. Someone may substitute for you at any time.

Times, Attendance and Location: There will be two sessions of the two-day courses this year. Please indicate which course you would like to attend.
