

Pesticide Continued Training for Category 3, 5, 6, and 18 Pesticide Category 3, 5, and 6 Training and Testing

Course Information: Pesticide Continued Training is for Categories 3, 5, 6, and 18. The seven-hour workshop provides three general hours and one specific hour for each of the three categories (3, 5, 6, and 18). We do not provide special certification testing for Categories 3 and 18. If you need certification for Categories 3 and 18, please contact the Department of Agriculture at 502-573-0282 or visit their website for testing locations: <http://www.kyagr.com/consumer/envsvs/testing/schedule.htm>.

Pesticide Training and Testing is for Categories 3, 5, and 6. To prepare workers to take the certification exam, we provide five hours of instruction, and at the completion of the training, the Department of Agriculture administers the exam. Pesticide certification and license questions should be directed to the Division of Environmental Services, Kentucky Department of Agriculture at 502-573-0282.

Date-Time-Location: A schedule of workshop dates and locations are listed on the registration form. Registration will begin at 8:00 a.m., class work starts at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 4:00 p.m. Fee includes all materials, refreshments, and lunch. Overnight accommodations are available by calling the number listed on the bottom of the page.

- The registration fee for Pesticide Continued Training for Category 3, 5, 6, and 18 is \$90.
- The registration fee for Pesticide Category 3, 5, and 6 Training and Testing is \$120 for one category, \$130 for two categories, and \$140 for three categories. The registration fees include the initial certification fee of \$25.

Course Changes: Please note that all courses are subject to change. If there are any changes, the registered party will be contacted immediately so adjustments can be made. If the required minimum of 20 registrations is not met, the course will be cancelled. Attendance will be limited to 40 participants.

Confirmation/Cancellation: An invoice/receipt will be sent to you upon acceptance of your registration. A confirmation letter and directions will be mailed two weeks prior to the course. If you are registered and cannot attend, please let us know at least two business days prior to the workshop. If we do not receive this advance notice, you will be charged the full registration fee; someone may substitute at any time. Requests for transfers must also be made two days in advance. Payment is due in advance.
